**Information on Registration  
Summer School 2018 (May 14 - August 17)  
(Registration for summer school begins February 19, 2018)**

**1. New format for summer offerings**

The summer schedule has been completely revised and all courses fall into one of three time frames:

- May 14 - June 29 (7 week session)
- July 2 - August 17 (7 week session)
- May 14 - August 17 (14 week session)

**2. How to register for summer classes**

- \* Meet with your advisor to decide what classes you should take;
- \* Talk to your Student Financial Services counselor to decide if you will use a student loan for summer courses or pay out of pocket;
- \* Once you have met with your advisor and Student Financial Services counselor, you can enroll through AccessAU for 9 credit hours or less (with SFS approval) between the dates of February 19 - April 25;
- \* You do not need to enroll through the Registrar's office unless you are enrolling after April 25 or for more than 9 credit hours;
- \* Dropping a class or adding additional hours will require approval of Student Financial Services.

**3. Don't see a course you are interested in?**

Individual reading courses may be arranged with the permission of the instructor. Talk to your advisor or the department that usually offers the course you are interested in.

**4. Cost for summer 2018**

The cost for summer 2018 courses is \$380 per credit hour, in line with the cost at other four-year institutions (both private and state) in Indiana.

Want to reduce the cost? Enroll in and earn a passing grade in courses totalling nine credit hours or more and receive a refund of \$380.

**Refund information**

All summer school withdrawals must be made by sending an e-mail to Dr. Jaye L. Rogers, director of summer school, at [jlrogers2@anderson.edu](mailto:jlrogers2@anderson.edu).

In order to obtain a full refund for courses dropped, contact must be made prior to the scheduled first day of class.

Registration constitutes a contractual agreement between the university and the student. Students withdrawing after a class has begun may be entitled to a reduction in tuition charges. Adjustments are based upon the date of official withdrawal. The official date of withdrawal will be the date the contact is made by e-mail.

Questions regarding tuition reduction should be e-mailed to the director of summer school.
