**Information on Registration
Summer School 2017 (May 8 - August 18)
(Registration for summer school begins February 20, 2017)**

1. Schedule of Classes Form

For all summer registrations, obtain a Schedule of Classes form from your advisor. List all courses and dates on one form. The class number of each course is used as the identifying designation. The student is responsible for checking the correctness of the class number on the form. Once the required signatures have been obtained, file schedule in the Registrar's Office or with Department of Adult Studies. **Students cannot register online for summer classes.**

2. Multiple Classes at a Time

If you wish to take short classes that overlap, the following is needed:

- A 3.0 cumulative gpa is needed to take two short courses that overlap.
- A 3.5 cumulative gpa is needed to take more than two short courses that overlap.
- A signature from the director of summer school is needed if above gpa requirements are not met for overlapping courses.
- A signature is not needed if registration includes all summer long courses.

3. Reading Courses--Work is done independently, preferably with scheduled assignments due throughout the summer. A 2.5 cumulative gpa required.

- For reading courses listed in the Master Schedule - Get a syllabus from the instructor and have the instructor and your advisor sign the registration form.
- Forms are available from the registrar's office for reading courses not listed in the Master Schedule.
- A signature from the director of summer school is needed for any exceptions to the above reading course gpa requirement.

4. Department of Adult Studies sections 50 and 5E can be taken by all students. Other Adult Studies sections (80 and 8E) can be taken only with special approval and under extenuating circumstances.

- Contact the Director of Summer School or the Department of Adult Studies for questions.

5. Financial Arrangements

- Make financial arrangements with your Student Financial Services Counselor.

May 8 - Last day to change schedule with no fee.

May 9 - \$10 Class Drop Fee on or after this date.

Refund information

All summer school withdrawals must be made by sending an e-mail to Dr. Jaye L. Rogers, director of summer school, at jlrogers2@anderson.edu.

In order to obtain a full refund for courses dropped, contact must be made prior to the scheduled first day of class.

Registration constitutes a contractual agreement between the university and the student. Students withdrawing after a class has begun may be entitled to a reduction in tuition charges. Adjustments are based upon the date of official withdrawal. The official date of withdrawal will be the date the contact is made by e-mail. Questions regarding tuition reduction should be e-mailed to the director of summer school.
